Visit the Bosworth Battlefield Heritage Centre to find out more about the historic battle in 1485 that would mark a turning point in England's history and the death of King Richard III. Look through the exhibits and go on a guided walk. The weekend of 19th and 20th August 2017 is the Bosworth Medieval Festival weekend with special events.
